Spring Break Adventure aboard a Duck

WISCONSIN DELLS, Wis. (March 16, 2011) – A sure sign of spring in Wisconsin Dells is the first sighting of Original Wisconsin Ducks. The amphibious tours are typically one of the first seasonal outdoor attractions to open each year providing spring break visitors a chance to get out and see the beautiful canopy of color that begins to emerge as winter gives way to the warmer weather.

“The spring season is a great time to see the landscape of the Dells region; it’s just very refreshing after being cooped up all winter,” said Dan Gavinski, general manager of Original Wisconsin Ducks, which is now open for its 2011 operating season offering amphibious tours daily from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., weather permitting.

Original Wisconsin Ducks take visitors on a scenic tour through exclusive wilderness trails featuring some of the most spectacular views of the region. The authentic WWII-era vehicles can travel on land and water, so of course, every tour includes two splashdowns. Often the favorite part of the tour, the Duck first splashes down into the Wisconsin River for a look at the layered sandstone cliffs that are the signature of Wisconsin Dells. After lumbering out of the water and a short jaunt on land, it’s another spectacular splashdown into Lake Delton. (Lake entry begins April 1).

“Visitors are often pleasantly surprised to see us open when they come into town for spring break,” added Gavinski. “A Duck tour is a great way for the entire family to do an activity together.”

Original Wisconsin Ducks is marking its 66th season of operation this year and continues to hail as one of the most-loved attractions in Wisconsin.

With more than 90 vehicles, Original Wisconsin Ducks is the largest “flock” of amphibious tour Ducks in the United States. There are about a dozen Duck tours nationwide with only about 300 operational Ducks combined. Original Wisconsin Ducks’ 2011 season runs mid-March through early November, weather permitting.
